JUNIOR CYCLE

At Scoil Ruáin, our 1st Year students engage with a comprehensive range of subjects, allowing them to explore various fields of study and develop essential life skills. This broad exposure ensures that students experience all aspects of secondary education before making their subject choices for 2nd Year.

In 2nd Year, students select their top four subjects based on their interests and strengths. While English, Irish, and Maths continue with both Higher and Ordinary level options, all other subjects are offered at a common level to ensure a consistent and equitable learning experience. Additionally, students will benefit from engaging in short courses and participating in up to 400 hours of well-being activities over their three years in the Junior Cycle.

JUNIOR CERTIFICATE SCHOOLS PROGRAMME (JCSP)

The Junior Certificate Schools Programme (JCSP) is a tailored intervention within the Junior Cycle, designed to support a student-centered approach to education. It provides a flexible curriculum framework that helps schools and teachers focus on the individual needs and strengths of each student, ensuring that every young person can achieve real success and have a positive school experience.

The JCSP emphasises active learning and the development of fundamental skills, aiming to make the school experience both enjoyable and rewarding. By fostering an environment of improvement and success, the JCSP ensures that all students can benefit from their time in school, enhancing their engagement and confidence throughout their educational journey.



LEAVING CERTIFICATE PROGRAMMES

At Scoil Ruáin, we offer three distinct Leaving Certificate programmes to cater to the diverse needs and aspirations of our students:

1. **Leaving Certificate (Established):** This traditional programme provides a broad and comprehensive education, preparing students for university or other higher education paths. It covers a range of subjects, allowing students to develop a deep understanding in their chosen areas of interest.

- 2. Leaving Certificate Applied (LCA): The LCA is a two-year programme designed for students who prefer a practical, vocationally-oriented approach to learning. This programme is ideal for students interested in hands-on, project-based work and those who plan to enter the workforce directly after school. It also provides a pathway to further education through Post Leaving Certificate (PLC) courses, such as FETAC Level 5 or 6, which can lead to higher studies at Institutes of Technology. The LCA includes one day per week dedicated to work experience, offering valuable real-world insights.
- 3. Leaving Certificate Vocational Programme (LCVP): The LCVP combines the traditional Leaving Certificate with additional modules focused on Enterprise Education and Preparation for Work. This programme enriches students' business skills and includes practical experiences such as work placements, career investigations, mini-enterprises, and business and community visits. It provides students with a solid foundation in both academic and vocational skills.

TRANSITION YEAR (TY)

Transition Year at Scoil Ruáin is designed to enhance students' maturity, confidence, and skills before they embark on the Senior Cycle. It offers a unique opportunity for students to explore a wide range of interests, develop social awareness, and engage actively in both school and academic life.

Purpose: TY helps students gain confidence and maturity while preparing them for their future educational and career choices. It also aids in informed decision-making for subject selection in the Leaving Certificate.

Selection Criteria: Admission to the TY programme is based on age, motivation, behaviour, and attendance. Applicants will also undergo an interview process to ensure the programme is a good fit.

Programme Highlights: All TY students participate in our annual school musical, an enriching experience that fosters teamwork and creativity. Additionally, TY provides opportunities for personal development through various activities and projects tailored to students' interests and goals.



SUPPORT FOR STUDENTS

Evening Study: All of our students have the opportunity to participate in two hours of supervised study each evening after school. This service is offered at a highly discounted rate and includes complimentary hot snacks, drinks, and healthy food options, providing an ideal environment for focused study and academic improvement.

BURSARIES

At Scoil Ruáin, we are proud to offer our 6th-year students the opportunity to apply for two prestigious third-level bursaries, provided by our valued corporate partners. These generous scholarships are designed to support students in their pursuit of higher education.

Camida offers a bursary of €3,000, along with an iPhone, to one deserving student. **Godolphin** provides a bursary of €1,500 per year of study (up to 4 years), along with a laptop computer.

Both companies have established an application process that includes an interview to select the successful candidates. They seek students who have demonstrated a strong work ethic in achieving their third-level goals and who have made significant contributions to both the school and the wider community.

These bursaries are a testament to the commitment of Scoil Ruáin and our partners in recognising and rewarding excellence, dedication, and community involvement among our students.

STUDENT COUNCIL

The Student Council at Scoil Ruáin is a vital representative body elected by the entire student population. It provides students with a platform to voice their concerns, share their opinions, and actively participate in the decision-making process within the school. Through the Student Council, students have a direct influence on school policies and initiatives, ensuring their perspectives are considered in shaping the school environment.

A designated member of staff serves as a liaison to the Student Council, facilitating communication and collaboration between the students and school management. Parents who wish to become actively involved in the school are welcome and encouraged to join the Parents' Association.

MUSIC GENERATION

Music Generation is Ireland's National Music Education Programme, initiated by Music Network and funded by the Department of Education and Skills. This initiative is designed to help children and young people access high-quality music education within their own communities. Scoil Ruáin has been selected as a hub for this exciting initiative, playing a key role in its implementation both within the curriculum and through extracurricular activities.

We offer after-school lessons in a wide range of instruments, including cello, violin, flute, accordion, concertina, guitar, bodhrán, ukulele, and tin whistle. These lessons are heavily subsidised, making music education more accessible to all our students.

While Bronze-level expeditions typically take place amidst the stunning landscapes of Ireland, those pursuing the Gold Award may venture further afield, laying the groundwork to become Ireland's next generation of accomplished explorers.

We are committed to ensuring that Gaisce remains an integral part of our Transition Year programme at Scoil Ruáin. THE AMBER FLAG TEAM

At Scoil Ruáin, the Amber Flag Team is made up of dedicated students from 1st to 6th year, all committed to promoting positive mental health within our school community. The team actively organises and leads initiatives as part of the Pieta Amber Flag programme, which focuses on raising awareness about mental health, reducing stigma, and supporting the emotional and mental well-being of our students and staff.

COISCÉIM



In 2015 with co-operation with the Department of Education and Skills Scoil Ruáin opened 'Coiscéim', an education facility for students with Autistic Spectrum Disorders (ASD).

A holistic approach is taken when planning for the education of the students with ASD. Following the information gathering and consultation process, an educational plan is developed that caters for the student's social, sensory and educational needs.

Students linked to Coiscéim attend mainstream classes and timetabled classes within the facility. Coiscéim is also available to students should they need to withdraw for an unscheduled class period. Classes within the Coiscéim are provided on an individual and small group basis. They are taught by a resource teacher and supported by special needs assistants.

Scoil Ruáin is currently in consultation with the Department of Education and Skills to finalise the designs of a purpose built classrooms for Coiscéim.
